2013 Green Drought!

Lack of substantial rainfall this year is a cause for concern. We have only had 497mm in the past year. Only in 2006 did we have less for any 12 month period in the last 20 years. So far this year to end of June, rainfall

at Acheron (east of the river) is 192.5mm. For the same period last year it was 482mm. Our average yearly rainfall should be around 800mm. But it's raining today with the promise of more to come.
