I am writing to provide a mid-year update from the Acheron Hall committee as we have quite a bit of news to share.

Firstly, we are very

pleased to announce that the renovations to the toilet block at the hall are finally completed. Special thanks to the Breakaway Twin Rivers Caravan Park who donated the tiles for the floor and for Michael Harper for getting the work done. The toilet block is now dry, clean and looks so much better, now that it has new toilets and been painted, rendered, repaired and waterproofed.

Our other exciting news is that we have just found out that we have been successful in obtaining a 'Tiny Towns' grant through the 'Department of Jobs, Skills, Industry and Regions' to re-surface the Acheron Tennis

Court. Many of you would be aware that the existing 99 year old court is badly cracked due to tree roots and 'old age' and is very difficult to play tennis on. The new surface will have the advantage of also having lines marked for two 'Pickle Ball' courts which is likely to appeal to Acheron residents of a wide range of ages and abilities. Once completed it will continue to be open and free for all to enjoy with families and friends.

We're having a small auction at the dinner. This is our major fund raiser, for the upkeep of our lovely old hall.



Acheron Rainfall

Rain Fall 2024: January - June

Rainfall at Acheron, recorded in the hills, east of the river, tells two different stories for the first half of 2024. In January this year, 184mm was recorded, and we have only received 265mm over the months February to June. This is significantly less than the 295mm received in the same five months last year.

However, the rainfall received over the last 12 months is 799mm, which is 105mm higher than the yearly average for the Acheron area since 1992.

community. It should be a fun night for everyone. More details to follow.


