Acheron Rainfall - Spring 2022

Spring Showers

It's not a surprise to discover that October 2022 was the wettest October we have experienced at Acheron over the last thirty years. Rainfall was recorded at 220mm. This is comfortably the highest October rainfall, the next highest being 197mm in 2000, and only the third time the monthly rainfall has reached 200mm in any one month.

Rainfall at Acheron is 764mm for the months January to period. 300

Average Annual rainfall

October 2022. Last year was 637mm for the same

Given that the long term forecast is for continuing high rainfall we can expect that the total rainfall for 2022 will exceed the long term average of 800mm. It

is currently trending towards 900mm. The map shows the historic annual rainfall for Victoria using a 30 year average.

These rainfall figures are measured in the hills on the East side of the river.

Murrindindi Council's Outreach Events

The Acheron Hall Committee has been contacted by Murrindindi Council with a request for them to have a presence at our Acheron Hall Christmas Party. The Council have an initiative of an OUTREACH PROGRAMME which offers some support and advice to Murrindindi residents who have been adversely affected by the recent flooding around the district and this includes Acheron. They want to be helpful.

Our Christmas party is a good opportunity for the Council to meet and talk to residents and the Acheron Hall Committee have agreed to Council's request.

Being adversely affected can include a wide range of circumstance, much more than having flood water inundate your home or paddocks.
