President's Message

Luncheon in February

A luncheon to welcome new ladies to the Acheron Community was a big hit (and a very hot one) and some 35 attended. Thanks to the organisers who did a great job.

Upgrades to the Hall

Following our submission to the Dept of Regional Development, we (via Murrindindi Council) have been granted funding of \$18000 towards the total Stage 2 Project of

\$28000. Our contribution consists of \$2184 as "In kind" labour and \$7816 from our own funds. We will need to raise some \$5000 to fulfill our cash obligations for this project.

In April we will submit the necessary documentation to the Shire and would hope that we have funding to commence the actual work in May. The Stage 2 project consists of a Storage room at the rear of the Hall connected

via a Deck. A ramp to this new area will also be constructed. Additionally we intend to install Air Conditioning and Heating into the Hall to make the use of the Hall much more appealing during the summer and Winter months.

The committee will be seeking support from the broader Acheron community to ensure the success of this project.
